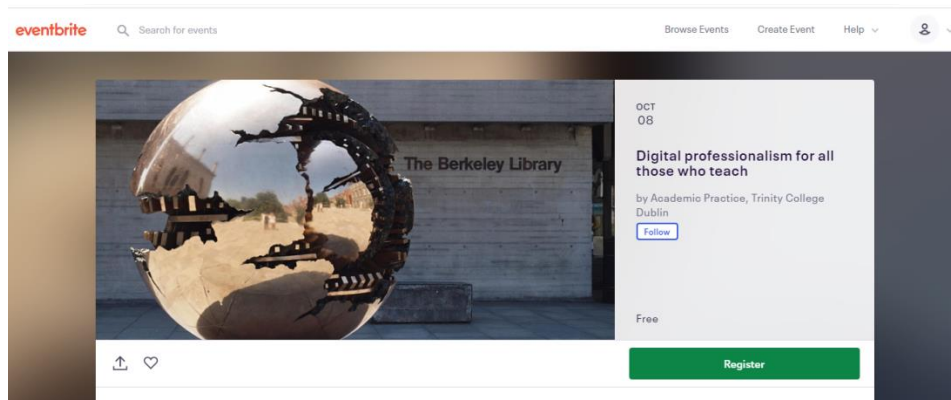

National Academic Integrity Week - Various Events Monday 19 to Friday 23 October 2020

Ireland's inaugural National Academic Integrity Week will take place from Monday 19 to Friday 23 October 2020. This programme of 14 online events aims to share guidance and best practice in upholding and cultivating academic integrity, including issues arising from academic misconduct and cheating, showcasing the voices of teaching and learning practitioners, as well as those of students themselves.

The programme, curated by Quality and Qualifications Ireland in collaboration with the [National Academic Integrity Network \(NAIN\)](#), will include webinars organised and hosted by Irish higher education institutions and agencies. The week will also feature events organised by the [European Network for Academic Integrity \(ENAI\)](#) and the [International Center for Academic Integrity \(ICAI\)](#) as part of International Day against Contract Cheating in which Ireland is taking part for the first time.

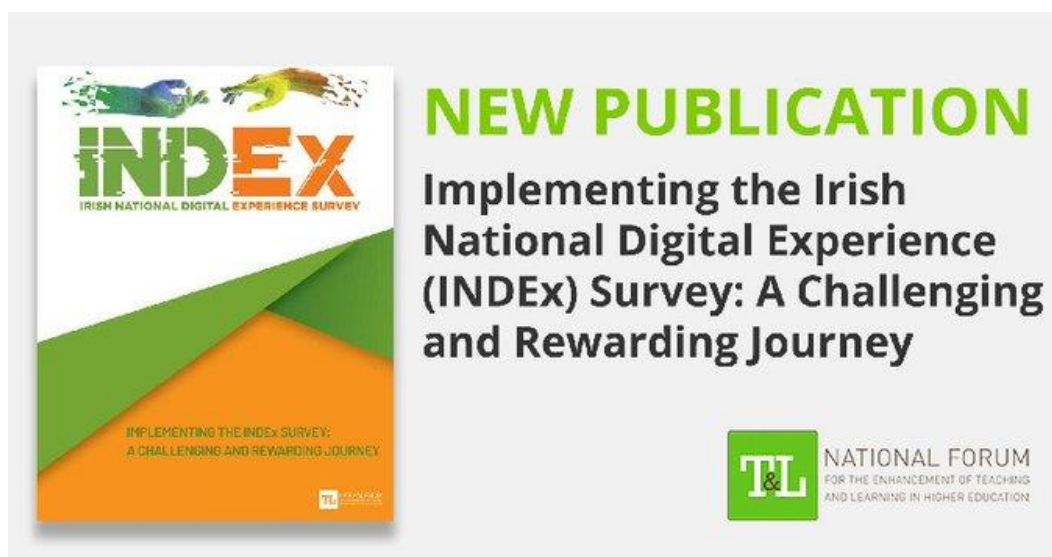

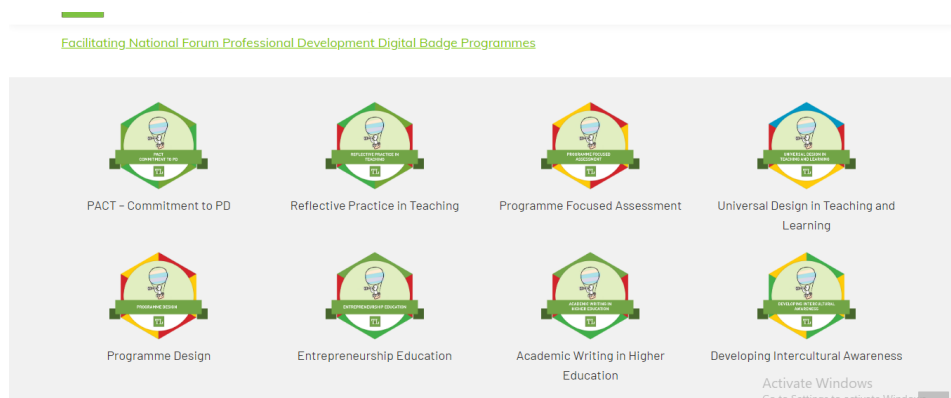
