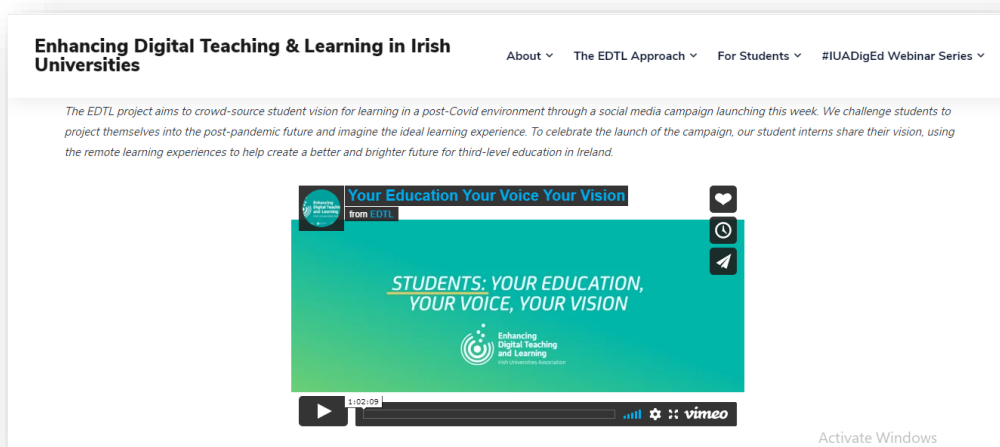

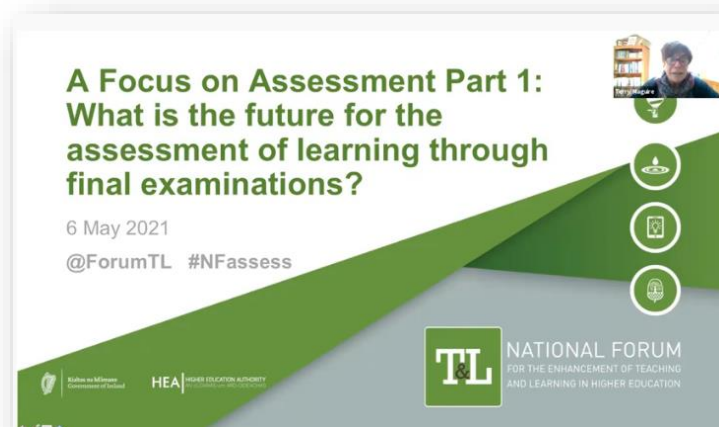

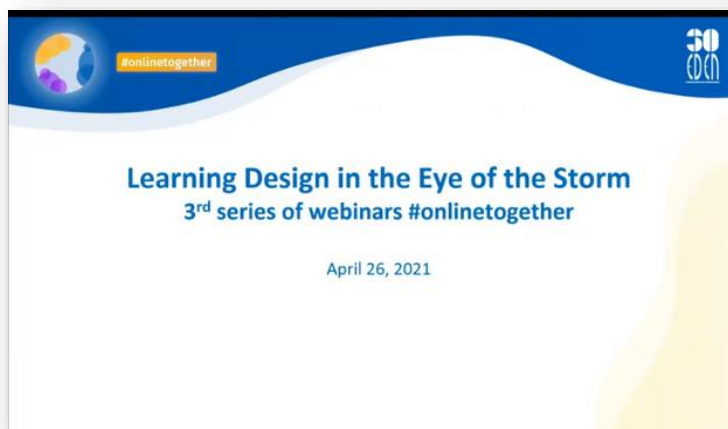

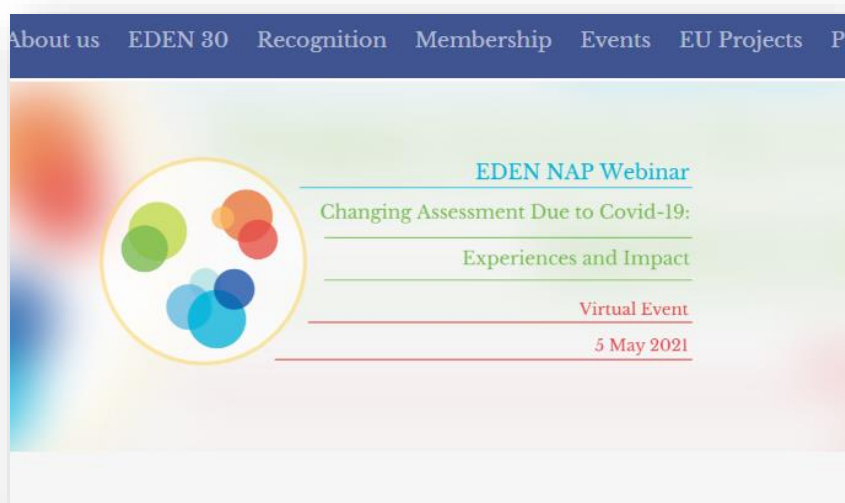


CCT Research Lunch and Learn Series
